- I. Call to Order: Don Perreault, Chair, called the Teaching and Learning Subcommittee meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

- II. Update on Portrait of a Graduate: Superintendent Martineau shared a document and timeline on Portrait of a Graduate. Dr. Martineau met with Patrice Nelson, Consultant with The Center for School Change and she will continue to meet throughout the summer and provide professional development with the Steering Committee. Press Releases will be released to *Harbor News* and to the community and information will be placed on the WPS website. Dr. Martineau commented this is being funded through a grant.

D. Perreault offered the Board's support.
Superintendent Martineau plans a Special meeting/workshop to disseminate information on Portrait of a Graduate. Starting in September, she will plan monthly releases and ask for quotes from the Board. Mini student focus groups will be formed. After several meetings take place a community conversation and in-person presentation will happen in April. D. Perreault talked about the Career Pathways link and asked Superintendent Martineau to keep the Board informed as to how to provide support.

She talked about Park and Recreation partnership, Career Pathways and the launching of new programs. She will write on the benefits of a small school and seek a quote from the Board Chair and use pictures in the news releases.
