Regular Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

The Regular Meeting of the Westbrook Water Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) was called to order by Chairman L. McNamar on Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at 7:05 p.m.

2. Correspondence

There was no new correspondence.

3. Ted Lane Field

L. McNamar attended a meeting with others in Westbrook to talk about what should be done with the money available from the State for municipalities as part of Covid relief. L. McNamar suggested using it for the passive nitrogen septic system at Seaside. The idea for the community septic system at Ted Lane Field was discussed as well. L. McNamar explained that there would be monthly fees businesses would have to pay for maintenance and replacement.

L. McNamar suggested scheduling a joint meeting with the WPCA and the Town Center Revitalization Committee/Economic Development Commission to talk about a community septic system at Ted Lane Field. S. Holbrook suggested that Brian Curtis, P.E., from Nathan Jacobsen and Associates, be invited to attend the meeting as well.

4. Riggio Building PNR System – Wastewater Sampling and Lab Testing

L. McNamar is hoping to get test results from Brian Curtis in the fall for the Riggio Building. S. Brainard suggested possibly opening up the bathrooms to fife and drum corps at the Riggio Building the day of the Westbrook Muster to give the bathrooms more use. It will be helpful for the testing.

5. Vote on Regular Meeting Minutes

The May 26, 2021 meeting was cancelled. There was no quorum at the June 23, 2021 meeting. An Administrative Session was held instead, so there were no meeting minutes to approve.

6. Invoices

S. Holbrook made a motion to approve a payment of \$400.00 for Jacobson & Associates for records. The motion was seconded by S. Brainard and was approved unanimously.
